Mindax Ltd was applied for two uranium exploration licences in the Carnegie area of Western Australia.

The licences cover 664 square kilometres including palaeochannels draining into Oneabunga. The drainages extend more than 88 kilometres.

Mindax said regional stream sediment samples had higher than usual uranium concentrations that could indicate mineralisation beneath cover in the channels.

The company will commence a detailed airborne radiomagnetic survey and an air-core drilling traverse once the tenements are granted.

Sydney - Tuesday - March 20: (RWE Aust Business News) - **Mindax** Ltd (ASX:MDX) has expanded its Western Australian uranium exploration portfolio with applications for two exploration licences in the Carnegie area, 300km west north west of Wiluna.

The company has applied for tenure over 664 square kilometres in two licences covering palaeochannels draining into Oneabunga (Lake Burnside).

Regional stream sediment samples collected in this area contain uranium at higher than usual (98 percentile) concentrations and may be indicative of mineralisation beneath cover in the channels.

The drainages extend more than 88km in length.

Once the tenements are granted the company intends to commence an exploration program that will include detailed airborne radiometric survey and aircore drilling traverses.

Mindax shares were steady at 16c.
