EXPLORATION UPDATE

YILGARN AVON JOINT VENTURE (Mindax 50% and operator, Quasar Resources 50%)

Two tenements were granted in the Yilgarn-Avon Project area at Elachbutting Hill and Westonia.

Elachbutting Hill includes uranium in water values greater than 190ppb within 14km of drainage and an adjacent strong 2km radiometric anomaly. Westonia is an area sourcing anomalous drainages and hosting a small (<1km) radiometric anomaly.

Radiometric traversing (~800km) is being selectively undertaken through the project areas to develop an understanding of the sources of elevated radioactivity.

A staged program of further water and surface sampling, airborne geophysics and aircore drilling has been implemented over the granted tenements.

Total tenements now comprise approximately 2,300 sq km. Eleven applications are expected to be granted from now through until April. The uranium in water data for the portfolio is derived from extensive proprietary data acquired by Mindax pursuant to the Collaborative Research Project with CRC LEME. The ongoing processing of this data, our own regional data and other public domain information is expected to result in further tenement applications in the wider joint venture area.
