EXPLORATION UPDATE

Mindax has identified a large uranium anomaly from the recently completed airborne geophysical coverage of its Maynard Hills tenements to the east of the new Lords gold mine of Troy Resources NL near Sandstone in WA.

Analysis of the highly detailed radiometric component of this data (50x70m sampling, 30m flying height) indicates a very significant uranium channel response associated with the Noondie lake system. This anomaly is 150-200 cps against a survey background of 5 cps and it extends over 20 km in length. The high U/Th ratio and its setting within the drainage suggests the anomaly is similar to those generated by the Yeleerie calcrete style of uranium mineralization. Mindax will commence ground based exploration as soon as practicable.

Two additional tenement applications have been made to fully secure this area and to allow detailed ground based exploration.

Mindax's land position in the Sandstone area now aggregates 1,600 sq km.

Mindax also has a continuing program of target delineation and drilling at a number of gold anomalies on its Maynard Hills tenements. These targets have been identified as a result of the regional program carried out over the past 6 months.
