EXPLORATION UPDATE

Mindax is exploring for gold and uranium in the Murchison area of Western Australia and has land holdings in excess of 1500 square kilometers through the area.

Work on the Lake Noondie project area is advancing with confirmation of selected airborne radiometric responses by ground traversing. These responses extend over 4 km along the lakebed as part of a 20 km zone of airborne uranium channel anomalism. Drilling is planned for late spring.

Mindax has lodged an application for an exploration licence over the Yeleerie area as part of the Company's Murchison exploration strategy. Yeleerie lies 140 km north east of Lake Noondie.

This area was previously subject to a State Agreement Act.

If the application is successful, Mindax will implement an extensive technical evaluation of the area.
