EXPLORATION UPDATE

- Mapping in progress at Mt Forrest iron project. Low contaminants indicated.
- Revised drilling approvals now in place within Yilgarn-Avon uranium JV.

Bulga Downs – Mt Forrest Iron (Mindax 100%)

Systematic mapping and surface sampling of the Mt Forrest iron formation has commenced. The program is focusing on structural positions that may host direct shipping hematite ores, similar to those at Jupiter's Mt Mason 60km further east. Results are expected early to mid October when drilling follow up is anticipated.

The target iron formations at Mt Forrest extend over 17 kilometers and the ironstone suite varies up to 2km in width. Mt Mason type targets have surface dimensions of 500x100 metres in areas of intensive faulting of siliceous iron formation (the silica is leached out of the iron formation in these positions).

Preliminary traversing on three selected wide spaced sections indicates multiple siliceous hematite-magnetite units varying from 30m to 200m in thickness. Samples confirm the very low levels of contaminants in this material as demonstrated in the tables below:

A further water sampling program is in progress in the Kellerberrin, Quairading, Kondinin and Hyden areas as part of the Co-operative Research Project with CRC LEME.

Permitting for reconnaissance drilling is proving very protracted but traverses on private land and some roadside drilling has been tentatively approved and a suitable drill rig is being sought.
