EXPLORATION UPDATE

PANHANDLE GOLD-COPPER-URANIUM PROJECT

Gold & Copper

Detailed gravity surveying on the **Panhandle Project**, located 130km south-east of Sandstone, has resolved two major shears and linking cross structures, which appear to control the gold-copper geochemistry of the project area.

The gravity survey was completed over an area where magnetic data indicates a shallow intrusive event.

The structural array has not been obvious on previous geological or geophysical data, but historical drilling shows it to be weakly mineralised. The most significant intercept is 2m @ 2.67g/t Au. Data from the gravity survey now provides a number of promising drill targets for gold mineralisation.

In addition to the structures, the survey area includes a discrete gravity feature which will be tested as a massive copper-zinc sulphide target.

Uranium

Surface geochemical sampling of strong radiometric responses in airborne data within the Panhandle Project area has returned assays of greater than 55ppm U (max 60ppm U) over a 2km section along the shore of Lake Barlee. Follow-up sampling is planned to identify a source of this response.
