EXPLORATION UPDATE

Bulga Downs Gold Project

Mindax Limited has received notice that the Mining Lease applications at Bulga Downs have now been granted. These cover the Paradise Bore gold resource and the adjacent mineralised Cabaret structure. Mindax intends to accelerate its gold program in the area with a view to establishing a 100,000oz position upon which to base a commercial operation.

Carnegie Uranium Project

Mindax Limited, through Mindax Energy Pty Limited has made application for tenure in the Carnegie area 300km west north west of Wiluna. The company has also entered into an agreement to secure a 70% interest in nearby EA69/2359 in the Carnegie area north west of Wiluna by agreeing to fund "decision mine". the project to to Reconnaissance geochemistry indicated has potential for mineralisation within calcretised drainages in the area. The project covers an area of 650km2.
